Hendrik Lackner is Law Professor at Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences. He teaches Public Law, e.g. Constitutional and Administrative Law as well as European Law. He is Academic Director of the China Competence Center which was founded in early 2013 at his University. Since 2009 Hendrik is Research Fellow of the Center for German Public Law of China University of Political Science and Law (CUPL) in Beijing. Since 2010 he is a permanent speaker at CUPL's annual German-Chinese Constitutional Law Dialogue. Hendrik published several articles on China's Rule of Law development and trained Chinese judges at China's National Judges College in Beijing. In 2017, Hendrik was awarded a visiting professorship at CUPL's Law School. Before his appointment as Law Professor Hendrik worked for five years as a Judge at the Administrative Court of Hamburg and before that as an Advocate in one of Berlin's big law firms. Hendrik studied Law at Hamburg University where he also obtained his Doctor Degree in Law. He is married with a Chinese-born lawyer and has one son.
